

STEMAZing Journal Hack

Here's a STEM on the Cheap hack for creating a STEMAZing Journal.

Materials

4 sheets of graph paper Scissors Writing utensil (pen or pencil)

Hack Directions

- 1. Separate the graph paper into two sets of two sheets.
- 2. Fold each set of sheets in half hamburger style and crease the fold well. We will call these Set 1 and Set 2.
- 3. Count five squares in on either side of the crease along the fold and draw a dot at that location. Do this to Set 1 and Set 2. You can see the dots in the images below.
- 4. Take Set 1 and make the cuts detailed and shown in the images below.




Image 1: Cut along fold until you reach the dot. Repeat on the other side.




Image 2: Set 1 with cuts complete.

5. Take Set 2 and open it back up. Now, fold Set 2 in half hotdog style as shown in the Image 3 below. Make the cut detailed and shown in the images below.




Image 3: Starting at the fold, cut along the hamburger crease until you reach the dot.





Image 4: Set 2 with cut complete.

6. Open up both Set 1 and Set 2. Take Set 1 and bend (do not crease) it in half hotdog style. Slip Set 1 into the cut in Set 2 as shown below.



7. Nest the cuts on Set 1 into the cut of Set 2 and open Set 1 up so it lies flat as shown below.



Fold the joined sets in half hamburger style, and there you have it – a STEMAZing Journal with eight graph paper pages. To make a journal with more pages, simply add more sheets to Set 1 and Set 2 before you start.


